

Minutes of DDC meeting held on 07/02/2017 in the conference hall of Deputy Commissioner's Office, Dhemaji.

Members present:- As per Annexure-I

The meeting was presided over by Smti Roshni Apranji Korati, I.A.S, D.C Dhemaji. Welcoming all the members present D.C initiated the discussion by following the last DDC meeting minutes. The meeting was discussed as follows:-

1. APDCL:- Responding to a statement raised by the Dist. Development Commissioner, Dhemaji regarding irregular power supply in the District since a few months back the AGM, APDCL informed that the power supply for the town is received from the Hatigarh power sub-station which is not sufficient to cater the electricity need of the District. He also informed the house that a new transformer is to be installed to meet the electricity requirement. Further he also appraised the house that F.I.Rs has been lodged against electricity thefts of the Bordoloni areas in the Gogamukh P.S.

The representative of the Dy. Director T&CP appraised the house that several electric posts have fallen in the alignment of the newly constructed drain in the Dhemaji town which are needed to be removed for proper execution of the drain. He also expressed the displeasure towards the APDCL for not paying due attention inspite of several correspondences in this regard. D.C strictly instructed the AGM, APDCL to take immediate action in this regard.

2. AGRICULTURE:- The D.A.O informed the house that training programme on groundnut cultivation is organized with VLEWS. He also appraised the house that mini lab for soil testing will be set up in every district. The Dist. Dev. Commissioner informed the house that realization of KCC loans from the defaulters in Dhemaji district is very poor. He suggested the DAO to set up a databank with Agriculture and allied deptts. D.C directed the DAO to prepare the list of defaulters ADO wise and call for a meeting with bank for the purpose.

3. EE, AGRI:- The EE, Agriculture informed the house that the beneficiary selection for powertiller distribution is completed under RIDF programme.

4. A.H & VETY :- The DVO appraised the house that a training programme has been organized with SHGS and poultry experts of north Lakhimpur Vety. College on poultry rearing as per direction of the D.C in the last DDC meeting. Required medicines & vaccines were also distributed.

5. DSWO:- D.C instructed the SPO to prepare an order to entrust Smti Arundhati Narah Mipun, C.O, Sissiborgaon Rev. Circle to monitor the overall functioning of the "Nutritional Rehabilitation Centre"(NRC) located at Silapathar Model Hospital for identification of severe acute malnourished children and to rehabilitate them in the model hospital so that no child is left behind who needs to be rehabilitated in collaboration with DSWO and JDHS Dhemaji and to send every weekly report to the DC.

6. D.F.D.O:- DFDO appraised the house that he has submitted a detailed list of shallow fisheries/ponds as desired by D.C in the last DDC meeting. DC asked him to submit the list of revenue fisheries immediately.

7. W & R Deptt:- The EE, WR appraised the house that he alongwith AEE, WR, Jonai & DRDA officials inspected the erosion affected areas on the right bank of Simen river and observed that erosion has affected about 2Kms in between Anandanagar and Lakhipara. Expressing the need to protect the erosion problem he stated that water resource deptt. will prepare a proposal in this regard and submit to PD, DRDA at an early date. He also inspected the Silasuti & Jalakiasuti areas where Dimow river affected the cultivation areas and villages namely Archipathar, Silasuti and Sivanagar due to siltation and considering the seriousness of the problem he stated that his deptt will carry out a through survey of then area and submit the report alongwith a proposal for remedial measures to PD, DRDA. He also inspected the Gainadi rightbank dyke at Bordham and Bhebeli village. He observed that the dyke is in damaged condition and several places and there is every possibility of the change of course of the river and affect the portion and to avert the problem it is decided to prepare an estimate by water resources Deptt and to submit it to the PD, DRDA

8. PWD (RR) & (ST.Rds):- EE, SR informed that some portion of Govt. land is being encroached by people nearby weekly bazaar area. Dc directed the C.O Dhemaji to look into the matter and take necessary action immediately.

9. P.W.D (N/H):- D.C Dhemaji directed the representative of PWD (NH) to submit a detailed project report in respect of the construction of portion of dilapidated road at Samarajan immediately.

10. P.W.D (B):- The EE, PWD (B) informed that

(a) Const. of model school at Lalungpathar village is going on and physical progress attained is about 89%.

(b) Const. of Engineering College is going on in full swing.

(c) Treasury Office building is being completed.

(d) Jonai Girl's hostel is going on in full swing and physical progress is about 72%

DC directed him to submit the plan & estimate for const. of auditorium at Habung with an cost of Rs-1(Crore) to be taken up under untied fund 2016 being identified by the Hon'ble C.M on priority basis.

11. SPORTS :- DC informed the house that youngsters of "Banai Community" at Jayrampur under Bordoloni Dev.Block hails from a very remote area who are very talented in different sports and are lagging behind due to their backwardness and ignorance etc. DC instructed the DSO to visit the areas to identify their potent and to distribute sports goods among them so as to encourage them.

12. H & T:- The Superintendent of H&T, Dhemaji appraised the house that the distribution of yarns to the beneficiaries is going on .

13. NAMAMI BRAHMAPUTRA FESTIVAL :- The Dist. Dev. Commissioner informed the house that the "Namami Brahmaputra" festival will be observed in Dhemaji Dist. alongwith the rest of other districts of Assam from 31<sup>st</sup> March to 4<sup>th</sup> April/2017 as per govt.instruction. Kareng Chapari & Poba Reserve Forest are being identified b the Dist. administration for the purpose.The names of the sub committees constituted for the celebration has been announced . D.C requested all the deptts to provide cooperation and necessary assistance for a successful celebration of the festival.

14). MISCELLANEOUS:- DC informed the house that DDC meeting will be held on every 5<sup>th</sup> day of every month in the conference hall of the Deputy Commissioner's office at 11.00 A.M. If the 5<sup>th</sup> day is a holiday the meeting will be held on the next working day.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the chair.
