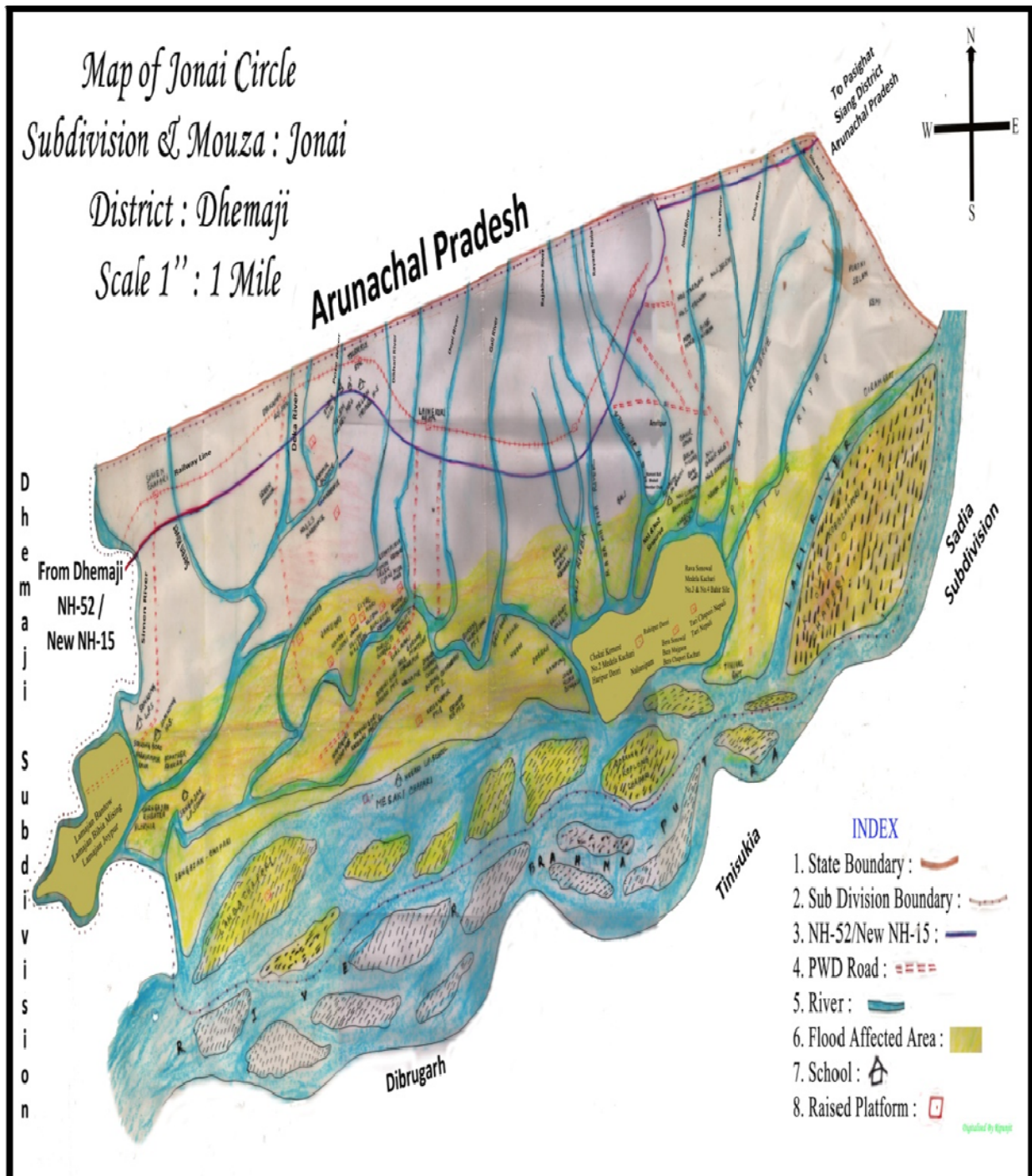

INTRODUCTION

Disaster threatens sustainable economic development worldwide. In the past twenty years, earthquakes, floods, tropical storms, droughts and other calamities have killed millions of people, inflicted injury, disease and caused homelessness and misery to around one billion others in the world. These have caused damage to infrastructure worth millions of rupees. Disaster destroys decades of human effort and investments, thereby, placing new demands on society for reconstruction and rehabilitation. Disaster management thus requires a multi-disciplinary and proactive approach. The community, civil society organizations, media and the proverbial man on the street, everyone has to play a role in case such exigency occurs. The various prevention and mitigation measures outlined below are aimed at building up capabilities as also how to deal with disasters.

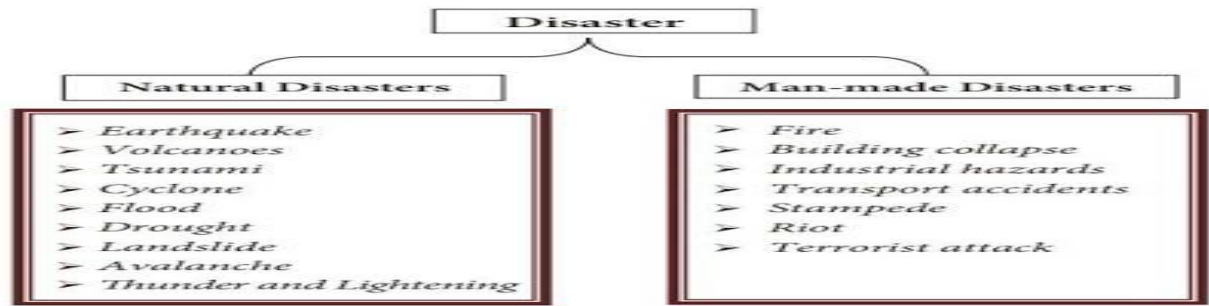


Fig1:showing different types of disasters.

The state of Assam is prone to natural disasters like earthquake, floods, landslides, fire, storm and occasional draught. As per National Centre for Seismology the North Eastern Region including Assam falls in a Zone called seismic zone Five. Zone 5 covers the highest risks zone that suffers earthquake of intensity more than 9 magnitudes. Natural hazard like flood, earthquake, and storm produces different amount of disastrous impact on different group of people which are in very vulnerable areas.

According to Disaster Management Act, 2005 “Disaster Management which includes both Risk Management and Crisis Management falls within the roles and functions of the State Government.” Till very recently, the widely practiced approach to Disaster Management was that of administering relief and rehabilitation. The Central Government had communicated certain guiding principles in 1883 in the form of a provisional code. Accordingly, a set of executive instructions were issued in 1959 and subsequently the “Assam Relief Manual” was prepared in 1976. The 1976 Manual lays stress on emergency situations arising out of floods, as floods are recurrent phenomena. It also briefly deals with such situations arising out of other natural calamities and certain special calamities like international border disputes not amounting to war or acute economic distresses. The manual was later revised into the Disaster Management Act 2005 (Appendix I) to incorporate other hazards like Earthquakes, Flash floods, Landslides, Cyclones and other man-made disasters.

OBJECTIVE OF THE CONTINGENCY PLAN

In order to improve the capacity building, mitigate the devastation due to any disaster and provide immediate relief the Circle Disaster Management Plan takes into account all local conditions, identify specific vulnerable areas, initiate necessary preparedness and mitigation measures, draw up capacity building plans, work out shelter sites, stockpile emergency provision of food, fodder, medicine, drinking water plan for deployment of personnel including utilization of the resources and work out budgetary provisions if required. It is carefully studied by Circle officer, Heads of Departments and the required provisions for resources at the sub-divisional levels are arranged. In this account the following objectives are chalked out as per the Assam Disaster Management manual -2015 to face the any sort of emergency during the year conducted :-

- Advance preparedness by division of work, trainings pre during and post disaster.
- To rescue and evacuate trapped people.
- To provide first aid to the injured.
- To take care of children, women and disabled person.
- To transfer the seriously injured and people needing urgent medical attention to hospitals to
- Provide shelter and relief to the homeless.
- To restore communication and essential services.
- To take urgent measures for maintaining law and order
- To take measures for disposal of the dead bodies and animal carcass to prevent outbreak of any epidemics.
- To take people to safer places in case of change of course by the rivers.

- Airway- Lilabari Airport under Lakhimpur district is about 180 Km from Jonai and Mohanbari Airport under Dibrugarh district is about 125 Km from Jonai.

MAJOR DISASTERS IN JONAI REVENUE CIRCLE

Throughout the year the circle faces different disasters either natural or manmade. The following are the different disasters, their potential impact and vulnerable areas that occurs in circle.

However the disaster that has the highest devastation ever year is flood. Jonai Revenue Circle is in flood prone area due to its topography and geographical location, numerous tributaries flow out from the hills of Arunachal Pradesh towards Jonai, which forms an intricate network of rivers. The entire Circle is in riverine tract and flood may last from weeks to months. Siltation is another major problem causing great damage to cultivation. The Revenue Circle is more flood prone due to the rivers Laika Lali, Sile, Rayang, Rajakhana, Depi, Dikhari, Pote Nola, Deka, Seren and Simen etc.

- In 2017, 3(three) people lost their lives.
 - In 2019, 3(three) went missing.
 - In 2020, 1(one) girl went died due to boat capsizing.
 - In 2022, 3(three) people died due to drowning in flooded waters.

FLOOD ZONES - JONAI

For better and prompt delivery of services, the Jonai Revenue Circle is divided into 6 Zones. Each zone is headed by a Nodal officer, who will be the overall in- charge of the allotted Zone. He will be assisted by the Assistants/Volunteers who will update and inform him from time to time flood related information for proper networking. The Nodal Officer will be responsible for transmitting and updating the daily situation report to the Sub-Division headquarters.

INCIDENT RESPONSE TASKFORCE

In order to render better service in Jonai Revenue Circle during any disaster specially floods there are several teams/committees under *Incident Response Task Force(IRTf)* which consists of Lot Mandal, Gaon Pradhan, GP President,VLCDMC members,local people, social workers etc. The incident response team is lead by Circle Officer. The IRTF based on their roles & responsibilities are futher catagorised into:-

Vulnerable Pocket Management Committee(VPMC)- Vulnerable ares that are prone to Floods have a VPMC which consists of Gaon Pradhan (Chairman), VLCDMC(Member), Ward Member(Member),Social Worker(Member).

Relief Distribution & Camp Management Committee-Each Relief Camps it consists of Camp in charge (Chairman), Lot Mandal (Member), Gaon Pradhan (Member), VDP (Member), Ward Member (Member), SocialWorker (Member). These committees look after the distribution of relief material inside the relief camps.

Village Relief Distribution & Management Committee-These committees looks upto the process of relief distribution in Disaster affected villages. Chairman of the Committee is the Gaon Pradhan and Lot Mandal, VLCDMC, GP President GP Secretary, Ward Members and Social worker from the village are the members.

Evacuation & Crisis Management Committee-These committeesare present in each Flood Zone and consists of Lot Mandal (Member), Gaon Pradhan (Member), Gram President (Member), Ward Members (Member), and VDPPresident (Member). They operate in rescue operations in collaboration with SRFD.

Revenue Circle Level Task Response Force- Consisting of Circle officer(Chairman),BDO(Member), O/C Of local Police Station(Member), Representatives from WRD,PWD(B), PWD(R),Irrigation, Agriculture, Health& FW, AH& Vet., Fishery, Education, Social welfare, Handloom& Textile, sericulture department as memebbers and Field officer, disaster management(Member Secretary).

PREVENTION & MITIGATION PLAN

FLOOD:

Flood mitigation refers to the measures aimed at prevention and preparedness. It reduces the actual or probable impact of floods on the people and their environment. The objective of flood mitigation is to control changes in the volume of run-off, peak stage of the flood, time of rise and duration of floodwaters, and location of flooding. The mitigation measures should be oriented to take proper care of these problems and thus will automatically reduce the impact of flood in the district. The various measures adopted for flood mitigation may be categorized in two groups structural and non-structural.

Structural

Construction of embankments/floodwalls along the river bank and improvement of the channel (by WRD).

Diversion of flood water (by WRD).

Careful location of new facilities, particularly community facilities such as schools, hospitals and other important infrastructure away from flood prone areas.

Non-structural

Collection of daily rainfall data (by WRD).

Flood forecasting and warning (by WRD & General Administration).

Prepare detailed floodplain map of the district, based on extent of land submerged, and assessment of damages. Analyze how the pattern of flooding has changed over a period of time (by WRD &General Administration).

Plantation in the catchment areas to check soil erosion (by Forest Dept),

Awareness programme.

STORM:

Jonai Circle is frequently strike by cyclonic storm during pre-monsoon season causing widespread damage to the crop and other properties. The main mitigation strategies for stormhazards are a well-informed public and an effective warning system. The following mitigation measures can be adopted to reduce the impact of cyclonic storm.

Planting wind breaks in the most vulnerable locations (by DFO).

Construction of strong wind safe public buildings which can be used for community shelter in settlements (PWD).

Crops can be protected by introducing agricultural practices and cultivation of those crops which are more resistant to high winds.

Compilation of meteorological data for forecasting of storm (by Deptt. concerned).

Public dissemination of information through mass media, poster campaigns and village meetings (by Circle).

FIRE ACCIDENT:

The following mitigation measures may be taken up to contain fire accident:

Installation of fire extinguisher cylinders in all institutions (by concerned institute).

Construction of fire hydrant in fire prone areas (by PHED/Police/DA).

Installation of fire warning systems in community facilities such as in school and hospitals (by concerned institute).

No attachment of thatch houses in govt. buildings (by DA).

EPIDEMIC:

The Health Department and Veterinary Department are the nodal agency responsible for monitoring and control of epidemics. Mitigation measures for control of epidemics would include:

Identification of areas prone to certain epidemics must be updated to access field requirements (by DMO & DVO).

Testing laboratories in district hospital must be well equipped and updated (by DMO).

Regular flow of data from both govt. establishment and NGOs run hospitals (by DA).

Isolating and rapid testing of person with symptoms of epidemic or person coming from affected areas/zones/states

ROAD ACCIDENTS:

Many lives were lost and casualties are reported annually due to road accident, which is caused due to reckless driving and poor road conditions. The following measures may be adopted to mitigate road accidents: -

Installation of speed monitoring machine in busy areas (by Transport Department, police).

Strict implementation of motor vehicle Act (Transport Department, Police).

Installation of traffic sign boards (by Police).

Carry of First Aid Box in every vehicle must be made mandatory (by Police/DTO (transport)).

Insurance of all vehicles must be updated (by Police).

Awareness about traffic rules should be imparted to all drivers and commuters through IEC (by police).

TRAINING AND AWARENESS GENERATION

Several Public awareness programs on Flood & Earthquake Preparedness conducted successfully in different villages.

Training of Task Force Members on Search, Rescue and First Aid conducted.

Conducting Earthquake Mock Drill in Educational institutions.

Conducting Flood Mock Drill in different Flood Prone villages.

Training on Earthquake and Flood Risk Mitigation and Management conducted in different schools and hospitals.

LESSONS FROM LAST FLOOD

The administration with the help of Circle Officer and its Staff has been successfully managing the disaster caused by hazards like Flood in every year, but there have been a number of lessons that need constant verification and updating for a successful execution of the plans.

Sufficient stocks of Food grains and cattle feeds need to be stored in several locations which are accessible during emergencies and from the relief operations can be carried out without hindrances.

The Pre designated nodal Officers for managing those Shelter camps within short notice.

The physical and mental health along with basic hygiene of people should be taken care during Flood. Especially health of pregnant women and vulnerable health groups in the relief camps should be strictly monitored and institutionalized, if there is a chance of delivery of medical emergency during flood.

Relief Camps must be ready prior to Floods.

Pre Flood mock drill must be conducted in the subdivision for better response during flood.
